



# I'll Say the Great Word

*I will sanctify also both Aaron and his sons, to minister to me in the priest's office. Ex. 29:44*




1. How of - ten I've pon-dered my strug-gles with-in, Be-tween the good Spir-it and in-dwell-ing sin,

5. All na - ture may per - ish, the heav-ens may fall, But Je - sus is ev - er my all and in all;




A foe in the tem - ple not sub-ject to God; But now I am free thro' the won-der-ful blood.
