

On Heavenly Heights

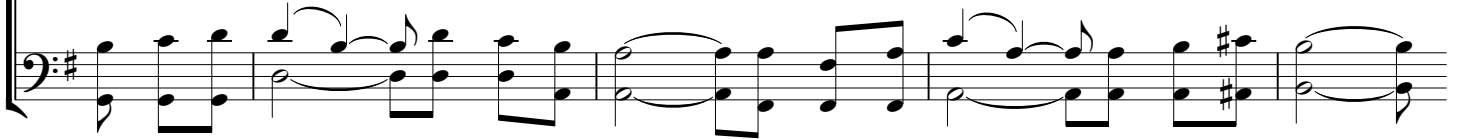
We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens. Heb. 8:1
