



# Sing On


Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, talk ye of all his wondrous works. 1 Chr. 16:9; Psa. 105:2

We swell a no - bler song; Where an-gels there are wait - ing To greet us on the shore,




And look-ing o - ver Jor - dan, I see the prom-ised land.
