

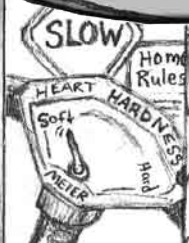

It was chore-time. Jay was glad no one saw him slip out the back door...

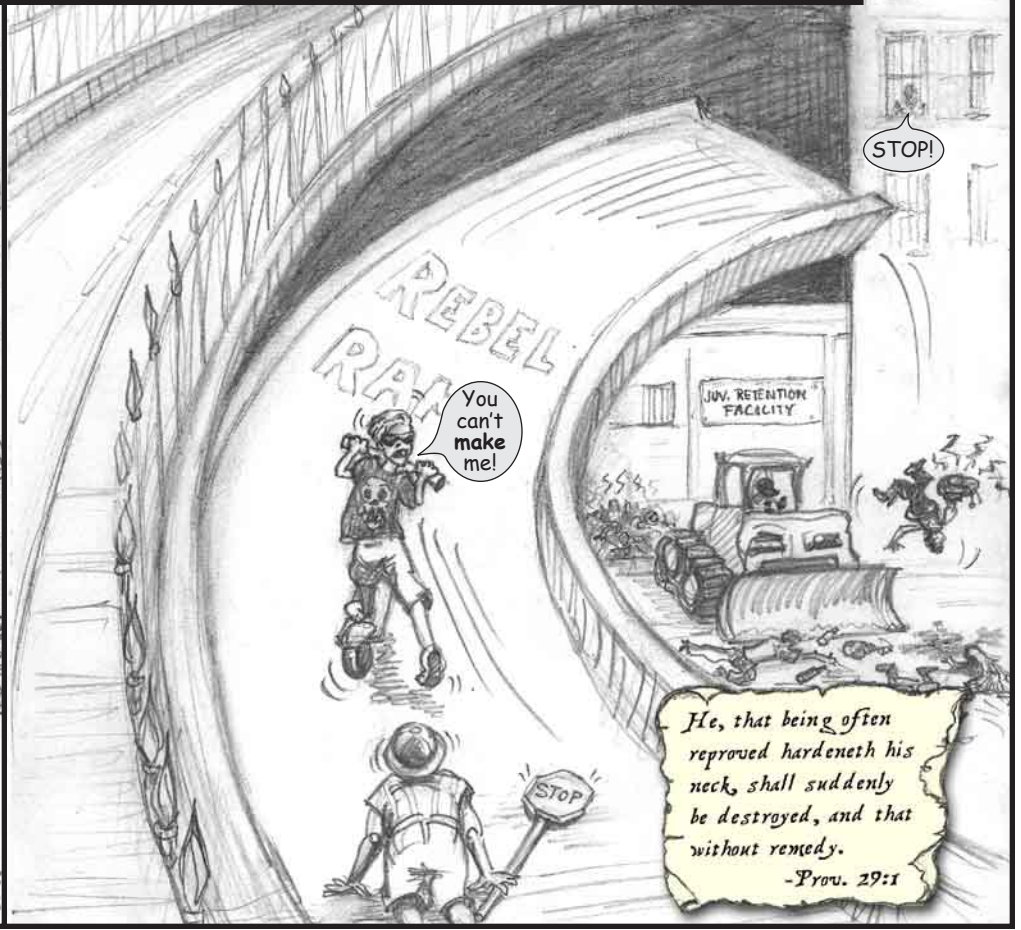


That's funny... I'm sure I had a stamped envelope in my purse.
