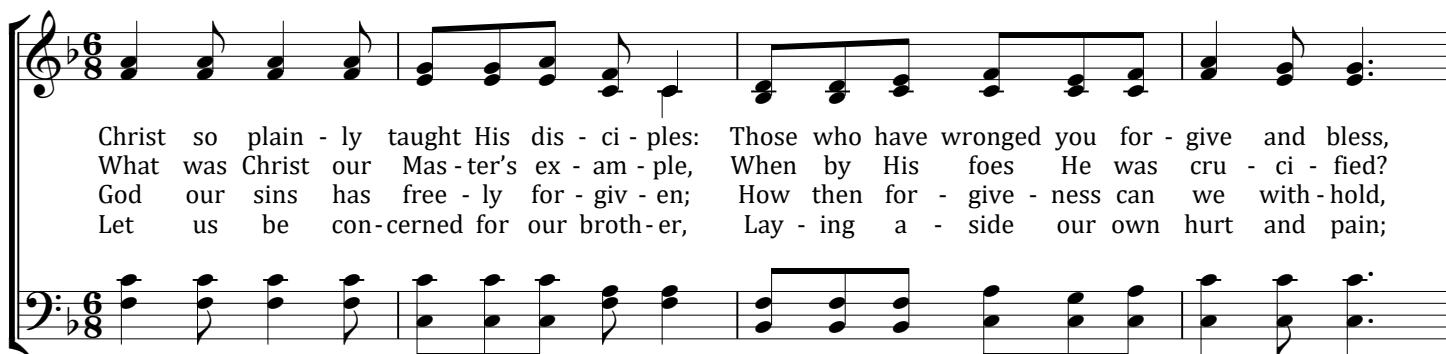


Forgiveness

Let us be con - cerned for our broth - er, Lay - ing a - side our own hurt and pain;

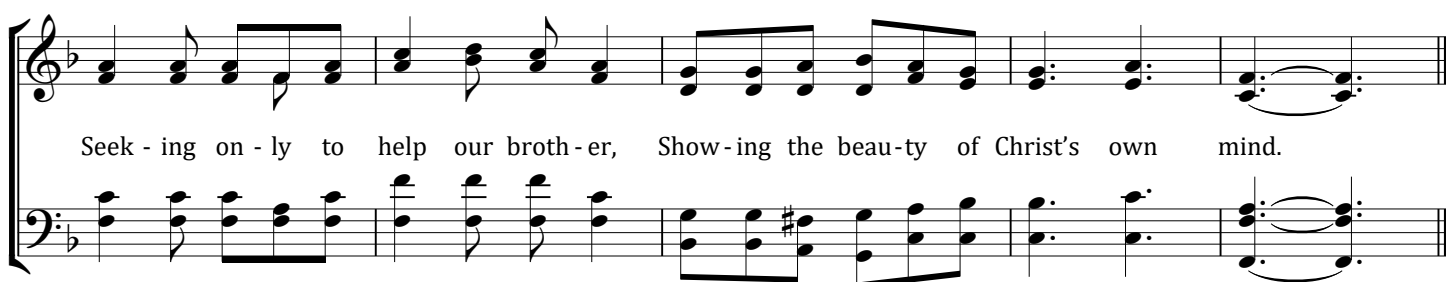


Show - ing love, for - bear - ance, and mer - cy, Free from all an - ger and bit - ter - ness.
