



Have You a Welcome?

4. Man-y un-grate-ful, de-spise and re-ject Thee, Oth-ers pro-fess-ing by works de-ny Thee more;




Thou hast a rem-nant that love Thy ap-pear-ing; Wel-come Thy com-ing, dear Lord, for Thine own.
