



I Would Not Have My Way




1. I would not have my way, dear Lord, but Thine; I would not walk a - lone, for I might fall:

3. I would not have my way, dear Lord, but Thine; I do not ask for beds with flow'rs en-twined:




Thou know - est what is best, so lead me on; I'll lis - ten, Lord, I'll hear Thy faint - est call.
