



Lean Upon the Breast of Jesus


*Trust in him at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before him: God is a refuge for us. Psa. 62:8
I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. Surely he shall deliver thee. Psa. 91:2-3*




1. Lean up - on the breast of Je - sus, Rest - ing through a storm - y night;
