



The Good Shepherd

Even so it is not the will of your Father which is in heaven, that one of these little ones should perish. Mt. 18:12-14*




1. A - far on the moun-tain the Shep - herd Is seek-ing the lost ones to save;

4. There in the green pas - tures He'll give thee A place of sweet com - fort and rest;




Oh, flee to the arms of His mer - cy, For thee His life free - ly He gave.
